50 YEARS AGO — 1969



the market, or using hot pepper products. "Squirrels don't like the 'heat' of the pepper, but it doesn't bother birds," he said.

Wild Birds Unlimited's region-specific, nofiller seed blends provide the nutrients birds need during all seasons. "Birds' nutrition needs in winter differ from those in spring and summer, so it's important to change seeds based on the birds' needs, along with the region they live in," Kostrobala said. "No filler in the seed blends means birds consume everything, so you won't find the cheap milo, that birds can't eat, under the feeder. And since the blends are designed for birds found in our area, you're providing exactly what is needed, at exactly the right time." New seed shipments arrive weekly, Kostrobala noted, meaning the seeds are fresher and more appropriate to birds' nutritional needs at the specific time.

While birds are the focus at Wild Birds Unlimited, there are also items available to make your outdoor living area prettier and more functional. 
